




It's nearly here! <u>Cast in Time: Duke of the West</u> is available for preorder on Kindle. Available June 28.




# More Mary Mary

solve differential equations in their head? Be prepared for a wild ride in cuteness, deadliness, and inventions beyond your wildest dreams.



#### The Richard Jackson Saga


